Electroconvulsive therapy (ECT), has been used for many years as part of the effective treatment of persons suffering from severe mental illnesses such as bipolar mood disorder. - you are pregnant and cannot take some of your medication;
- You can't take medication due to another medical condition; or
- + You are having suicidal thoughts
