COVID-19 TESTING

The correct process for getting tested for COVID-19

PLEASE FOLLOW THE STEPS OUTLINED BELOW IE:

- You have acute respiratory illness with a sudden onset of at least one of the following symptoms: cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, fever of 38°C or higher, body aches, chills, loss of smell or taste, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue or weakness
 - If you have a respiratory illness and have been in close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19; travelled to areas with local transmission of COVID-19; OR worked in or visited a healthcare facility where COVID-19 positive patients are treated
- Get a healthcare practitioner referral or recommendation from the National Institute for Communicable Diseases (NICD)
- The pathology testing form will be provided to you
- Go to the designated laboratory indicated by your healthcare practitioner or NICD
- The results will be communicated to you by your healthcare practitioner or NICD
- Observe the necessary precautions:
 - **Self-isolation** if you are indicated by your healthcare practitioner to do so
 - **Social distancing** keep at least 2 metres between yourself and other people, avoid direct contact
 - Observe hand hygiene
 - **Cover your cough and sneeze** with your flexed elbow or tissue
 - **Avoid** touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
 - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
 - Wear a face mask as per current legislation
