

Emergency Units

The international triage coding system

Priority of patients' treatment is based on a coding system. This enables emergency staff to see the most critical patients first.

How it works:

Priority colour	Target time	Management
Red	Immediate	Receives immediate attention in a resuscitation room for emergency treatment
Orange	<10 minutes	Very urgent management required
Yellow	30 – 60 minutes	Urgent treatment required
Green	±1 hour	You may have to wait longer if there are patients with more serious injuries or illnesses (codes red and orange) to attend to

5 important things to keep in mind while you're waiting

- 1. Staff will keep patients informed about the waiting period.
- 2. If your condition deteriorates while waiting, you should update the triage personnel immediately.
- 3. Each patient is important, and staff do their best to ensure everyone is seen timeously.
- 4. Give the nurse or doctor an accurate account of your symptoms.
- 5. During peak times, when the emergency unit experiences high volumes, waiting times could be longer.
